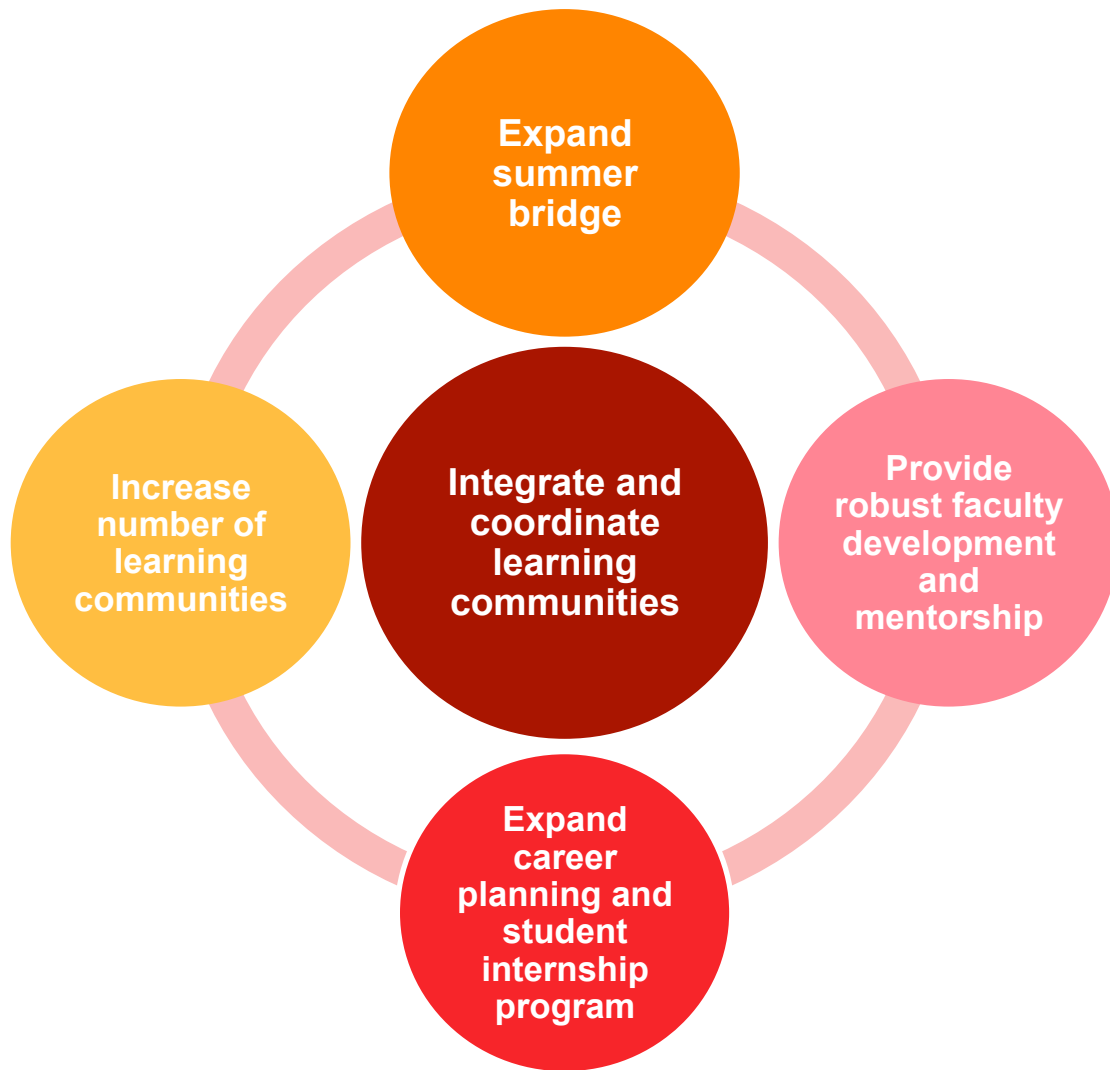

Five main components



Increase number of learning communities

COURSE	NON-LEARNING COMMUNITY STUDENTS	LEARNING COMMUNITY STUDENTS
STATISTICS	62%	72%
PRECALCULUS	48%	69%
ENGLISH 1A	63%	83%
ENGLISH 2	74%	85%


- Low income, first generation, first year in college students
- General education class success rates for students in learning communities are 10%-25% higher than for students not in a learning community.
- 9 existing formal learning communities (FLOW, Impact/AAPI, LEAD, LinC, MPS, Puente, REACH, Umoja)
- Expansion such as with LGBTQ+, women in STEM, and students of color in STEM
- Hire a Learning Communities Counselor with emphasis on underserved and LGBTQ+ populations

Expand Summer Bridge

- Summer bridge serves as a pipeline to learning cohorts
- Week-long program
- Current summer bridge serves 100 students every summer
- Expand the capacity by 300% to 400 students every summer by 2026.

Expand career planning and student internship program

- Part-time Internship Developer
- Peer mentors to assist with Handshake
- Bridge from college to workforce
- Expand capacity through Villages and wrap-around services at EPIC Center



Integrate and coordinate learning communities



- Students not in a learning community (96%) sometimes struggle in seeking out services
- Ethnic and Pride Inclusion Center (EPIC)
- Guided Pathways Villages
- Wrap-around services and community





100 → 400

300% increase in number of students participating in Summer Bridge

30% of De Anza students who talk about career plans through Villages
